### DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another class if desired.

**Special pre-beginners** : To compete in this special class a handler or dog must not have won a first prize in this class or any other standard obedience class. Heelwork will be done on the lead : recall off lead, no finish : one minute stay on the lead, position of your choice.

**Pre-beginner** : To compete in this class a dog or handler must not have won first place in either pre-beginners or any other standard of obedience class.

**Beginners** : To compete in this class a dog or handler must not have won a total of two or more first places in a beginners class or won first place in any other standard obedience class (pre-beginner excepted).

**Novice** : For dogs that have not won two first places in a standard obedience class (pre-beginners and beginners excepted).

**Class A** : For dogs that have not won three first places in class A, B and C in total.

**Class B** : For dogs which have not won three first places in Class B and C in total.

**Class C** : Open to all dogs.

### Kennel Club Rules and Regulations

**These Rules and Regulations are to be read in conjunction with The Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from The Kennel Club.**

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the UK Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G, under which this show is run. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the UK Kennel Club Regulations G available from the UK Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Obedience Shows must be registered with the Kennel Club of Jersey in accordance with the Kennel Club Regulations.
2. Puppies under 6 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete at Kennel Club of Jersey Licensed Obedience Shows.
3. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months and over. Dogs must be registered with the Kennel Club of Jersey with their full details on the entry form.
4. The Committee reserves itself the right to refuse entries.
5. This show is limited to first sixty dogs.
6. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Club will refund fees less reasonable incurred expenses on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within one month of the show date
7. All classes will have a full running order and dogs will work to this order unless cleared by the Chief Steward.
8. Timed stays will take place after each class is finished.
9. For the duration of the show all dogs including those in the exercise area of the show must be on a lead except when competing or practicing prior to the competition.
10. No animal other than one officially entered will be brought into the precinct of the dog show during its continuance except any dog registered to assist the disabled or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes. However, at the discretion of the Show Club a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
11. A dog will be disqualified and removed from the show if it is: (a) a bitch which is in season; (b) suffering from any infectious or contagious disease; (c) interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent; (d) of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety to any person or other animal; (e) likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
12. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
13. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
14. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
15. Should circumstances so dictate to the Society in consultation with the judges may alter the arrangements as necessary, such changes and circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club of Jersey.
16. Prize money NIL.
17. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a Vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
18. **WELFARE OF DOGS.** An exhibitor, (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club of Jersey Licensed event, should take all responsible steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation will be referred to the Kennel Club of Jersey who may refer it to the General Committee for disciplinary action under UK Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
19. The use of a toy or food as an incentive in the ring between, or during exercises, is prohibited.
20. Use of mobile phones, clickers and squeaky toys is prohibited around the ring areas.
21. The only proof of posting of entry acceptable to the Committee is a certificate of posting issued by the Post Office.
22. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
